Salina Initiative for Restorative Justice

SIRJ offers Victim-Offender Mediation

- Victims have a say over how their losses can be restored.
- Victims learn answers only the offender can give.
- Victims and offenders can see each other as real people.
- Victim and offender work together to find a way to make things right.
- Offenders can take responsibility for their actions and work to repair harm.
- State-approved local mediators keep the process safe, honest and helpful.
- Offenders in the program are less likely to commit future crimes.

What if the Victim Doesn't Want to Participate?

SIRJ can convene a **Neighborhood Accountability Board (NAB)** made up of local, trained volunteers to sit in place of the victim and on behalf of the community, to hold the offender accountable and work out an agreement to resolve the offense.

Contact **SIRJ** if you would like to receive training to become a NAB member.

What if the conflict is between an Adolescent and a Parent?

SIRJ can convene a **Parent-Adolescent Mediation (PAM)**.

Contact **SIRJ** if you or someone you know could use Parent-Adolescent Mediation.

SIRJ is a collaborative approach with better outcomes than court. The process is proven in the U.S. and worldwide, saving time, money and lives.

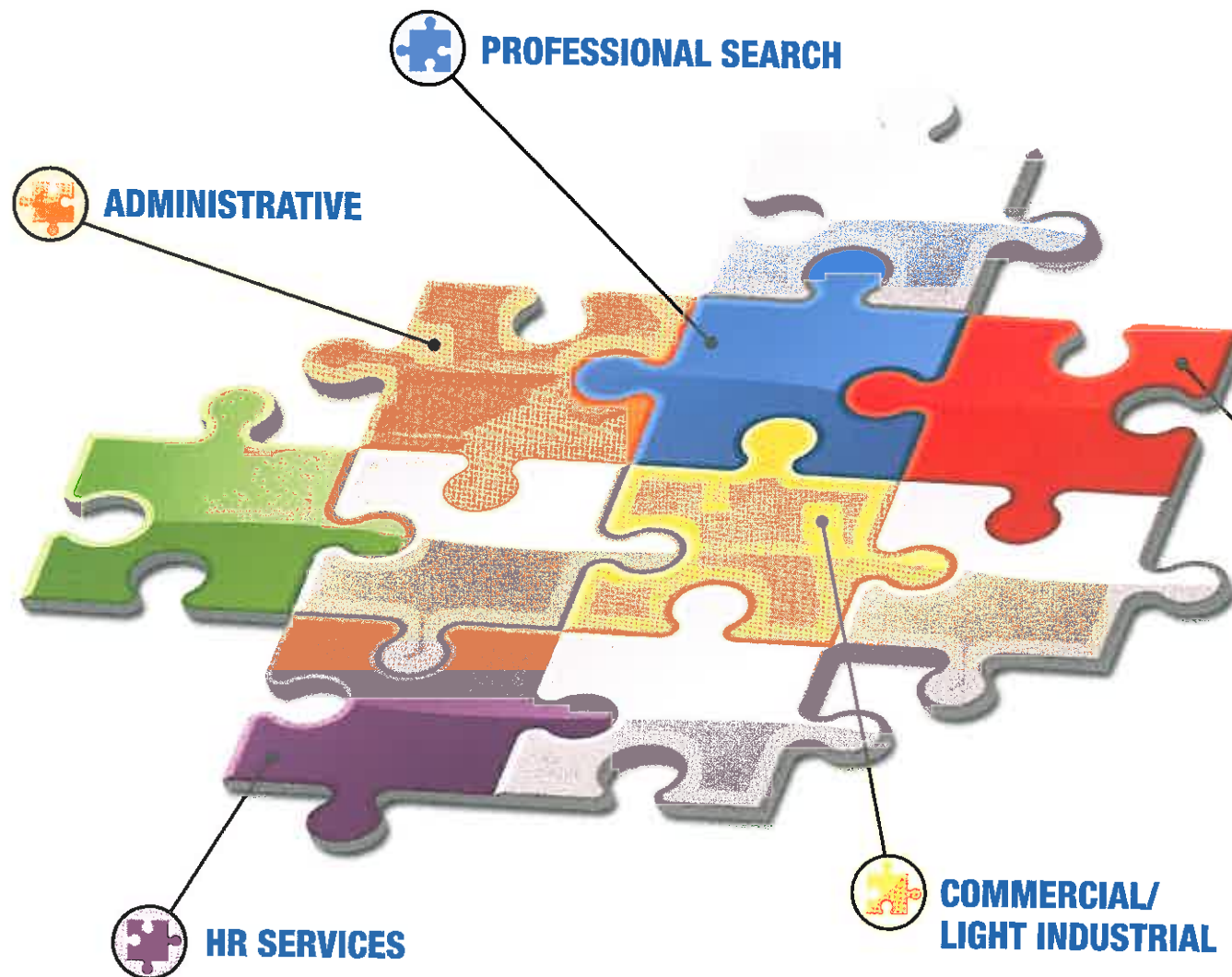
